#### AMAZING CREATIONS PRESCHOOL RELAUNCH UPDATE

February has been set aside for pledging to support the possible relaunch of Amazing Creations Preschool. Brochures and letters were sent to all members to prayerfully consider pledging to continue this St. Luke ministry. \$300,000 is needed to relaunch ACP. The Endowment Committee has set aside \$86,000 for this purpose and a total of \$94,200 has been received in pledges. That means we need \$119,800 more to reach our goal!

Look at the poster in the narthex that Adeline Skov and Aimee created to monitor our pledging progress! The poster is updated weekly with Aimee unveiling the poster each Sunday! Thanks, Aimee!

On February 11 Stefanie Luna and her family talked about their positive experience with ACP. Last Sunday Linnea Shieh talked about her experiences with both CCNS, a Co-op preschool, and ACP. Questions have been raised about having two preschools on one campus so Linnea explained the two different models and why they would not be competitive.

Last Sunday, we heard from Walt Wilser about his positive experience in having a garden in the playground area. Also, Kirk Austen gave an update of the poster.
