

## AMAZING CREATIONS PRESCHOOL RELAUNCH UPDATE

Since February was a short month, ACP pledging has been extended. Letters and brochures did not reach members until the middle of the month so now there will be more time to get in pledges. \$300,000 is needed to relaunch ACP. The Endowment Committee has set aside \$86,000 for this purpose, and a total of \$117,300 has been received in pledges; \$96,700 is needed to reach our goal!

Adeline Skov and Aimee have been monitoring our pledging progress! The poster is updated weekly with Aimee unveiling the poster each Sunday! Thanks, Aimee!

On February 11 Stefanie Luna and her family talked about their positive experience with ACP. On February 18 Linnea Shieh talked about her experiences with both CCNS, a Co-op preschool, and ACP. Questions had been raised about having two preschools on one campus so Linnea explained the two different models and why they would not be competitive.

On February 25 Walt Wilser talked about his enjoyment of having a garden in the playground area. If you are interested in providing healthy vegetables for preschool children, see Walt!!

On March 3 Mike Colligan gave an update on the completion of the MEB and of our hope to keep three rooms for our own St. Luke use. Mike will be giving weekly updates.
