WHAT'S NEW IN PLEDGING FOR ACP?

Aimee will add 20,000 new seeds to the pledging poster for ACP. Watch for the unveiling today! Thank you, Aimee!

In February the congregation approved the plan to accept pledges for seed money to relaunch Amazing Creations Preschool with the understanding that \$300,000 would be required for startup costs. At this time, \$137,300 has been received in addition to the \$86,000 given from the Endowment Fund. That leaves \$76,700 needed to reach the \$300,000 goal. We are encouraged by the generosity shown during the pledging drive. Therefore, we have decided to extend the pledging campaign window as we search for our preschool director. Please give this ministry your prayerful consideration.
