## OLD NARTHEX, RESTROOMS & CRY ROOM

The first impression of a visitor is often the most important one for them to decide whether they like a place or not. When our spaces seem unmaintained or cluttered, we give a poor impression to our visitors. Our physical space should always feel welcoming and inviting to visitors. Our "Old Narthex" needs a lot of work. Its dark and cluttered. It tends to be the final resting place for things. This is especially bad for an area where the bulk of the worshipers enter and where our only bathrooms in the building reside.

Thankfully, there are three separate projects planned for that space and possibly more in the future.

- 1. The witness team will be creating a "Cross Wall" on the far wall and will be improving the lighting throughout that space.
- 2. The Scouts will be commissioning a mural on the wall shared by the sacristy and cry room, and they will be pulling down the old wooden paneling and painting and cleaning up the space.
- 3. The cry room will be reorganized, decluttered and cleaned up.

We will be putting comfortable seating in the space too, to make it a more comfortable and usable area. Down the road, the bathrooms (at least the men's bathroom) will need some TLC as well.

Please help to make this space as clean and open as possible as we begin to make these improvements.
